- Health Care (*general medical care, eyeglasses, hearing aids, home health, hospice, others*)
- Education/Learning Opportunities (*early childhood education, primary and secondary school, post high-school opportunities, homework clubs, tutoring, after school activities, recreation, swimming, summer workshops, business consulting, workshops, others*)
- Youth Development (*activities that support youth developing their talents and gifts, mentoring*)
- Social-Emotional Support (*mental health, substance use, grieving support, new parent support, other supports*)
- Economic Opportunity (*jobs, living wages, small business opportunities, business consulting and workshops, sustainable tourism, others*)
- Transportation/Communication
- Safety/Emergency (*domestic violence, sexual assault, emergency planning, community safety, others*)
