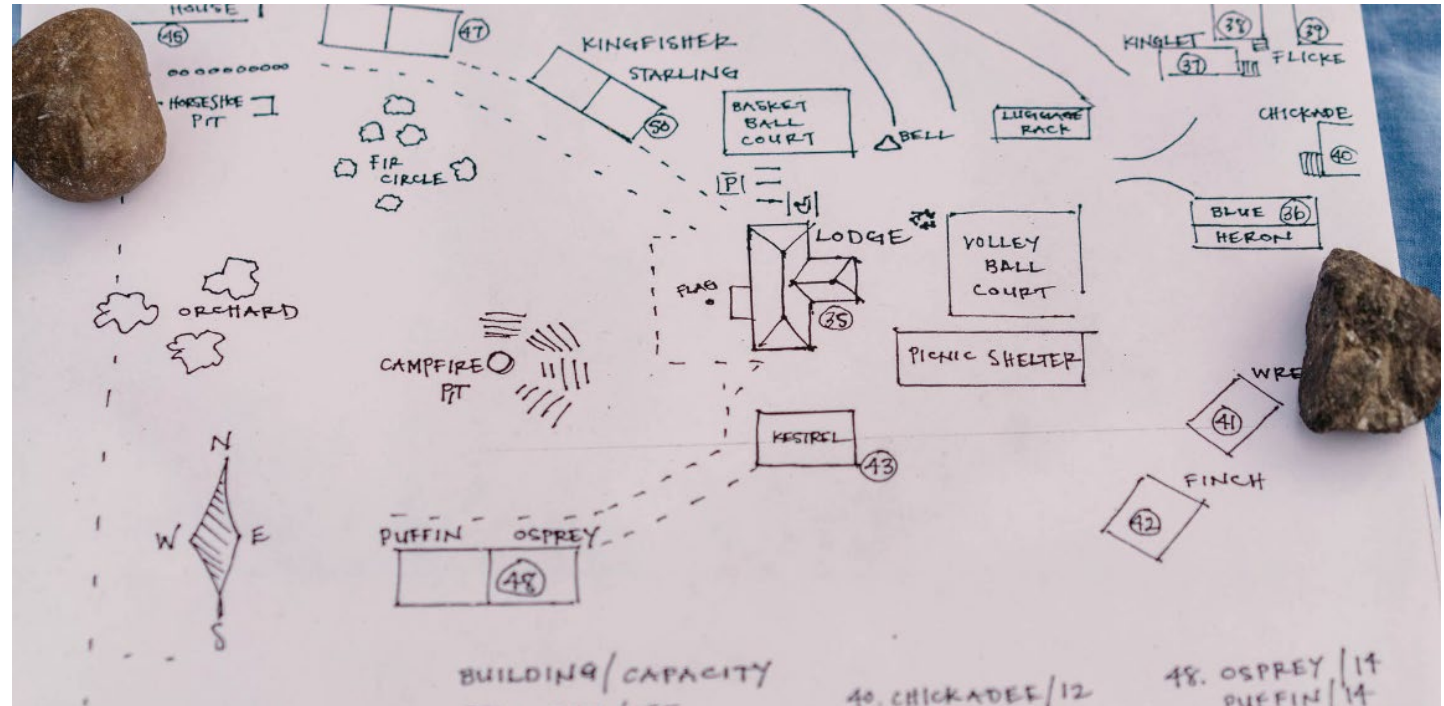


Lodging & Campground

Camp Moran ELC

(Environmental Learning Center)

- We'll have exclusive of the facility: all grounds, fire pit, cabins with bathrooms, lodge, commercial kitchen, outdoor kitchen, courts.
- Camp Moran is ringed by Ranger Housing. It is safe and protected by WA State Park. It is on a private access road across from Mt. Constitution.
- Cabins have heat, bunk beds, bathrooms with shower, electricity.
- Lodge has wood burning stove, electricity, heat/fans, meeting room.
- There is no wifi at Camp Moran and very limited cell connectivity!
